Interested in a career in the commercial road transport?
Designed in consultation with industry, MITO's training programme will provide you with the entry-level skills and knowledge to undertake tasks such as vehicle loading, yard person duties and basic driving as directed.

Programme outline

The Level 3 work-based programme is expected to take 9 months to complete.

The training programme includes a mix of practical training and assessment, undertaken in the workplace, and eLearning, allowing you to complete theory elements of the programme at your own pace. You will have access to videos, learning activities and course assessments, which can be easily accessed at any time and from any device – mobile phone, tablet or PC.

Entry requirements

You must be employed full-time in the industry and hold the correct vehicle licence required to enrol in this programme.

2024 programme fee

\$211 (excluding GST). Note this is a fixed fee and is non-refundable. Some learners may be eligible for the Government's Fees Free scheme (up to two year's free fees) – check your eligibility at feesfree.govt.nz.
