- Safely drive either a Heavy Rigid (Class 4) or Heavy Combination (Class 5) vehicle (dependent on the strand you select)

- Select and record routes
- Prepare a heavy motor vehicle for use.

You can choose to further your learning by completing the National Certificate in Commercial Road Transport (Goods Service Senior Driver) (Level 4) which will enable you to:

- Demonstrate advanced driving techniques and a professional attitude to driving
- Mentor new drivers and be a role model
- Communicate effectively with colleagues and managers
- Apply organisational policies and procedures
- Manage a group of drivers and vehicles.
