

## **JANET LANE MNZM SCHOLARSHIP**

Please read these terms and conditions carefully to ensure your application is considered.

- The Janet Lane MNZM scholarship for a future leader pays the programme fee for a leadership training programme that will develop personal leadership skills.
- To be considered for the Janet Lane MNZM Scholarship, applicants must apply for and gain admission to the programme they are intending to use the Scholarship for. Admission to the programme is a prior condition to the award of the Scholarship.
- One scholarship is available, up to \$20,000. Janet Lane MNZM Scholarship funding is guaranteed for up to two years of study.
- Applicants must be a New Zealand citizen or permanent resident.
- Applicants must be working full-time in the automotive, extractives, gas or transport and logistics industry and have the support of their employer to undertake the training programme.
- Applicants must have completed an NZQA recognised programme of study at Level 5 or above and demonstrated leadership qualities both at work and within their community.
- Applicants will have held a supervisory management position for a minimum of two years.
- The scholarship will not be awarded to applicants that are enrolled in another training programme with any other tertiary provider.
- The scholarship must be started within one year of it being awarded.
- The successful recipient is to submit a report three months into the commencement of study and once the programme is completed.
- The scholarship can only be awarded once per person and is not transferable to another person.
- The scholarship is not transferable to another place of employment should you change employer before the scholarship is completed, unless the new employer is within the same industry and they are willing to support you; and your previous employer and MITO both agree to the transfer.
- MITO will publish details of the scholarship recipients and may ask for further information to help promote MITO's training programmes and the scholarship programme.
- A selection panel will be convened by MITO's Executive Director. The panel reserves the right to request further supporting information. The panel's decision is final.
- Incomplete applications or applications received after 5pm Sunday 15 December 2024 will not be considered.
