- 2 It is recommended that people seeking credit for this unit standard first hold credit for Unit 17976, *Demonstrate knowledge of operating a light four wheel drive (4WD) vehicle in an off road environment*.
- 3 Evidence presented for assessment against this unit standard must be consistent with safe working practices and be in accordance with applicable service information, and company and legislative requirements. This includes the knowledge and use of suitable tools and equipment.
- 4 Legislation, regulations and/or industry standards relevant to this unit standard include but are not limited to the current version of the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015; and any subsequent amendments and replacements.
- 5 Definitions
Company requirements refer to instructions to staff on policy and procedures that are available in the workplace. These requirements may include – company policies and procedures, work instructions, product quality specifications and legislative requirements.
light 4WD vehicle means any four wheel vehicle with a gross laden weight less than 3500kg and capable of having motive power applied simultaneously to all four wheels. It does not include an all-terrain vehicle;
off-road means a surface other than a sealed or unsealed road or track and includes but is not limited to bush tracks, beaches, river beds and open paddocks;
Service information may include – technical information for a vehicle, machine, or product detailing operation; installation and servicing procedures; manufacturer instructions; technical terms and descriptions; and detailed illustrations.

Outcomes and performance criteria

Outcome 1

Develop a plan for off-road light four wheel drive (4WD) driving.

Performance criteria

- 1.1 Planned route is consistent with the characteristics and capabilities of vehicles and is within drivers' abilities.
- 1.2 Plan includes environmental conditions confirmed as suitable for the journey.
- 1.3 Plan includes a communication and safety plan.
- 1.4 Plan includes vehicle equipment to be inspected for condition and suitability for the journey.
